

By-Law No. 2017-158

A by-law of the City of Ottawa to levy taxes for the year 2017 for police services

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WHEREAS section 312 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001, Chapter 25, as amended, provides that the Council of a local municipality shall, after the adoption of estimates for each year, pass a by-law to levy a separate tax rate on the assessment in each property class including any adjustments made under Sections 32, 33, 34, 39.1 or 40 of the *Assessment Act* for local municipality purposes;

AND WHEREAS it is necessary for the Council of the City of Ottawa to levy on the assessment in each property class in the local municipality rateable for local municipality purposes according to the last assessment roll for the City of Ottawa as amended by the Municipal Property Assessment Corporation the rates set forth in Schedule A hereto attached which will provide a sufficient sum for the said purpose of police services;

THEREFORE the Council of the City of Ottawa enacts as follows:

1. For the year 2017, there shall be levied and collected on the assessment in each property class in the City of Ottawa according to the last assessment roll for the City of Ottawa as amended by the Municipal Property Assessment Corporation, the rates of taxation per current value assessment for police services as set out in Schedule A, attached hereto.
2. The amount raised by the levy provided for in this by-law shall be reduced by the amount previously raised by the interim levy in 2017 and collected.
3. For payment-in-lieu of taxes due to the City of Ottawa, the actual amount due to the City of Ottawa shall be based on the last assessment roll for the City of Ottawa as amended by the Municipal Property Assessment Corporation and the tax rates for the year 2017.
4. That every owner shall be taxed according to the tax rates in this by-law.
5. If any section or portion of the by-law or of Schedule A is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid it is the intent of the Council of the City of Ottawa that all remaining sections and portions of this by-law and of Schedule A continue in force and effect.

6. Schedule A attached hereto shall be and forms a part of this by-law.
