BY-LAW NO. 2017 - 260

A by-law of the City of Ottawa to establish certain lands as common and public highway and assume them for public use (Dunrobin Road, Russell Road, Kelly Lane, Harnett Road, Catherine Street, Randall Avenue, Kenaston Street, Paden Road, Snake Island Road).

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Ottawa deems it appropriate to establish as common and public highway and assume for public use certain lands in the City of Ottawa;

AND WHEREAS Section 31 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, empowers a municipality to pass a by-law for establishing and laying out highways;

AND WHEREAS in accordance with subsection 5(2) of the City of Ottawa Act, 1999 being Schedule E to the Fewer Municipal Politicians Act, 1999, c. 14, S.O. 1999, the City of Ottawa stands in the place of the old municipalities as defined under the Act for all purposes;

THEREFORE the City of Ottawa enacts as follows:

1. The following lands are hereby established as common and public highway and assumed for public use:

- (1) (Dunrobin Road)  
Part of Lot 24, Concession 3, March, designated as Part 3 on Plan 4R-29918, City of Ottawa.
- (2) (Russell Road)  
Part of Lot 1, Concession 6 (Rideau Front), Gloucester, designated as Part 1 on Plan 4R-27846, City of Ottawa.
- (3) (Kelly Lane)  
Part of Lot 15, Concession 1, Osgoode, designated as Part 5 on Plan 5R-3012, City of Ottawa.
- (4) (Harnett Road)  
Part of Lot 13, Concession 1, Marlborough, designated as Part 70 on Plan 5R-2310, City of Ottawa.
- (5) (Catherine Street)  
Part of Lots 12 and 13, Plan 30, South Catherine Street, designated as Part 1 on Plan 4R-22893, City of Ottawa.
- (6) (Randall Avenue)  
Part of Block N, Plan 552, designated as Parts 13 and 14 on Plan 4R-30371, City of Ottawa.

- (7) (Kenaston Street)  
Part of Lot 26, Concession 2, Ottawa Front, Gloucester, designated as Part 2 on Plan 4R-30383, City of Ottawa.
- (8) (Paden Road)  
Part of Lot 8, Concession 2, Marlborough, designated as Parts 3 and 4 on Plan 4R-30161, City of Ottawa.
- (9) (Snake Island Road)  
Part of Lot 20, Concession 2, Osgoode, designated as Part 2, on Plan 4R-30165, City of Ottawa.

2. This by-law shall come into force and take effect when it has been registered in the Land Registry Division of Ottawa-Carleton.
