A by-law of the City of Ottawa to amend By-law 2016-326, being the regulation of permanent signs on private property, to address window signs

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BY-LAW NO. 2018 - 42

A by-law of the City of Ottawa to amend By-law 2016-326, being the regulation of permanent signs on private property, to address window signs.

The Council of the City of Ottawa enacts as follows:

1. Amend Section 1, "window sign", by striking out ", but does not include an "open/closed" or "vacancy/no vacancy" sign" after the word "building".
2. Amend Section 26, paragraph (1) by striking out the word "and" at the end of clause (k) and by striking out the "." and substituting "; and" at the end of clause (l).
3. Amend Section 26, paragraph (1) by adding the following:

"(m) an illuminated window sign, limited to those displaying "open/closed" or "vacancy/no vacancy" messages."
4. Amend Section 139, Table 3B, by striking out the text in clause (b) of Endnote 5, and substituting "it displays only static messages that do not change with the exception of a sign that displays either "open/closed" or "vacancy/no vacancy", which may alternate occasionally, subject to sections 83 and 105;".
