BY-LAW NO. 2018 - 64

A by-law of the City of Ottawa to amend the fees in By-law No. 2013-360 regulating the municipal water supply.

NOW THEREFORE Council of the City of Ottawa enacts as follows:

1. Schedule "A", Fees and Charges, of By-law No. 2013-360 entitled "A by-law of the City of Ottawa to regulate the municipal water supply", as amended, is amended by repealing page 1 in Schedule "A" and the Schedule "A" page 1 attached hereto is substituted therefor.
2. This by-law is deemed to have come into force and take effect on January 1, 2018.
