BY-LAW NO. 2018 – 79

A by-law of the City of Ottawa to amend By-law No. 2017-92 respecting the regulation of Right of Way patios on City highways.

Council of the City of Ottawa enacts as follows:

1. That By-law No. 2017-92 entitled “A by-law of the City of Ottawa to regulate Right of Way patios on City highways” is amended by adding a new subsection 5(5) containing the following:

5. (5) Despite clause 5(4)(a) the General Manager may permit a pedestrian clearway that is less than 2m at all times where the sidewalk next to any pre-existing front, curbside or streetside patio or café seating patio for which approval was granted by the City prior to the coming into force of this by-law is less than 2m or is separated from the patio by infrastructure unrelated to the patio itself.

2. That the said By-law No. 2017-92 be amended by replacing subsection 62(2) with the following:

62. (2) Despite subsection (1), subsection 5(2) and clauses(a), (b) and (e) of subsection 5(4) will only come into force on October 31, 2018 with respect to any pre-existing front, curbside or streetside patio or café seating patio for which approval was granted by the City prior to the coming into force of this by-law.

3. This by-law shall come into force and take effect on March 28, 2018.
