BY-LAW NO. 2018 – 125

A by-law of the City of Ottawa to amend By-law No. 2002-189 respecting various minor amendments.

The Council of the City of Ottawa enacts as follows:

1. Section 1 of By-law No. 2002-189 entitled “A by-law of the City of Ottawa respecting the licensing, regulating and governing of certain businesses”, as amended, is amended by:

- (a) repealing the definition of “License Committee” and substituting the following definition therefor:

“Property Standards and License Appeals Committee” means the Committee established pursuant to the provisions of this by-law;

- (b) adding the following definition:

“service animal” means:

- a) an animal that can be readily identified as one that is being used by the person for reasons relating to the person’s disability, as a result of visual indicators such as the vest or harness worn by the animal; or
- b) an animal for which the person provides documentation from one of the following regulated health professionals confirming that the person requires the animal for reasons relating to the disability:
- i. A member of the College of Audiologists and Speech-Language Pathologists of Ontario,
  - ii. A member of the College of Chiropractors of Ontario,
  - iii. A member of the College of Nurses of Ontario,
  - iv. A member of the College of Occupational Therapists of Ontario,
  - v. A member of the College of Optometrists of Ontario,
  - vi. A member of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario,
  - vii. A member of the College of Physiotherapists of Ontario,
  - viii. A member of the College of Psychologists of Ontario,
  - ix. A member of the College of Registered Psychotherapists and Registered Mental Health Therapists of Ontario;

2. Sections 2(3), 3, 4, 5(1), 6(1), 6(2), 6(3), 6(4), 6(4)(d), 6(5), 6(6), 7(3), 12(2)(b), 19(4), 19(6), 20(10), 23, 24, 24(b), 25(a)(ii), 26(1), 26(5), 26(6), 27, 28, 29(1)(b), 44(5), and 44(6) of the said By-law No. 2002-189 are amended by repealing the words "License Committee" where they occur and substituting the words "Property Standards and License Appeals Committee" therefor.

3. The said By-law No. 2002-189 is amended by repealing the heading "ESTABLISHMENT OF LICENSE COMMITTEE" immediately preceding the subheading "COMPOSITION" preceding Section 3, and substituting the heading "ESTABLISHMENT OF PROPERTY STANDARDS AND LICENSE APPEALS COMMITTEE" therefor.

4. The said By-law No. 2002-189 is amended by repealing the subheading "LICENSE COMMITTEE POWERS" immediately preceding Section 6, and substituting the subheading "PROPERTY STANDARDS AND LICENSE APPEALS COMMITTEE POWERS" therefor.

5. The said By-law No. 2002-189 is amended by repealing the subheading "LICENSE COMMITTEE DECISION" immediately preceding Section 27, and substituting the subheading "PROPERTY STANDARDS AND LICENSE APPEALS COMMITTEE DECISION" therefor.

6. The said By-law No. 2002-189 is amended by repealing the subheading "IMPLEMENTATION OF LICENSE COMMITTEE DECISION" immediately preceding Section 29, and substituting the subheading "IMPLEMENTATION OF PROPERTY STANDARDS AND LICENSE APPEALS COMMITTEE DECISION" therefor.

7. Section 37 of the said By-law No. 2002-189 is repealed and the following Section substituted therefor:

37. No person licensed under this by-law shall refuse to permit a service animal to enter and remain on his or her premises, or to enter and remain in his or her motor vehicle during the carrying on of the business in respect of which the license is issued.
